

More About Using Documentary Books for Reluctant Readers

Below are articles about the use of visual images, in the form of picture books for young children, graphic novels for reluctant readers, and wordless books and photographs that address the use of a visual art form as a reading motivation tool. The research, especially in the area of picture books, is extensive. My theory, and I have seen it in practice, is that documentary photography books, serving as picture books for reluctant YA readers, work the same magic that picture books and graphic novels have already proven to do.
