Whereas, she was an active member of the Library & Information Technology Association (LITA), serving on the joint ALCTS/LITA Metadata Standards Committee and as Chair of the Brett Butler Entrepreneurship Award Committee; and

Whereas, she was an active member of the Association of College & Research Libraries (ACRL), serving as a member of the Samuel Lazerow Fellowship Award Committee; and

Whereas, she was an advocate for research on and promoted scholarship about cataloging and technical services as a member of the Editorial Board of *Cataloging & Classification Quarterly*; and

Whereas, she was acknowledged by her peers for her work through the awarding of the Samuel Lazerow Fellowship for Research in Acquisitions or Technical Services in an Academic or Research Libraries; now, therefore, be it
