Summary of Changes in ALA-Accredited Programs Fall 2010 - Fall 2011

**BACKGROUND**

Summarized here are changes in student enrollment, faculty, and funding for ALA-accredited programs between fall 2010 and fall 2011. Previous reports are available at the Office for Accreditation reports and publications page available from [www.ala.org/offices/accreditation](http://www.ala.org/offices/accreditation).

Data for this summary is extracted from statistical trend spreadsheets prepared by the ALA Office for Accreditation based on information that institutions provide annually, by December 1. The statistical trend spreadsheets track changes over the period of years since the Committee on Accreditation (COA) began reviewing statistics in 1992. Each program receives an updated trend summary spreadsheet from COA every spring with a letter responding to the program's statistical report.

**SUMMARY RESULT HIGHLIGHTS**

Overall for this period, total student headcount in ALA-accredited programs decreased by 1,743. The total headcount for fall 2011 is reported as 19,128, bringing enrollment back to the levels reported in 2007 when the figure was 19,530. Table 1 shows 22 programs reporting a drop in enrollment of at least 29 students.

Minority enrollment decreased by 62. The total overall is 2,860, 15% of all enrollees. Table 4 shows a change equilibrium with an increase for 24 programs and a decrease for the same number of programs.

Full-time faculty declined by 18 compared to an overall increase of 25 in the previous year (2009-2010) and 22 the year before (2008-2009).

Total program income increased by \$22,708,907 compared to \$12,093,624 between 2009-2010 and \$22,708,907 between 2008-2009.
