

6. Standard 1 Action Examples

The action examples included in the following pages present possible ways that Skills, Dispositions in Action, Responsibilities, and the Self-Assessment Strategy of Self-Questioning might be woven into inquiry-framed learning experiences.

The Sample Tasks and accompanying Assessments are based on actual learning activities shared by library media specialists from several states. It is important to emphasize that the sample performance tasks described here are *examples only*. These examples are intended to serve as catalysts for readers to develop and share additional contributions over time using the Action Examples Template provided at the end of this document.

This draft of *Standards for the 21st-Century Learner in Action* provides Action Examples for putting Standard 1: Inquire, think critically and gain knowledge, into practice in Benchmark Grades 2, 5, 8, 10 and 12+. Examples for Standards 2, 3, and 4 will be included in the second draft, expected to be posted for public comment in September 2008.
