

ALSC/Baker & Taylor Summer Reading Program Grant

This grant is designed to encourage outstanding summer reading programs by providing financial assistance, while recognizing ALSC members for outstanding program development. The applicant must plan and present an outline for a theme-based summer reading program in a public library that is open to all children (birth -14 years). The committee also encourages innovative proposals involving children with physical and/or developmental disabilities. The \$3,000 grant, made possible by Baker & Taylor, is to be used to support the program. These funds must be used by August 31st, 2024. Individual libraries within a larger system are welcome to apply.
