

CIPA Resolution

Adopted by the Florida Library Association February 2001

WHEREAS the Florida Library Association adopted its Internet policy which states:

The Florida Library Association commends Florida libraries for their landmark success in providing Floridians with access to the Internet, computers, and authoritative electronic information.

The Florida Library Association reaffirms the right of local governments and libraries to establish policies which reflect community norms and standards regarding the use of computer resources.

The Florida Library Association believes libraries should provide Internet services in a manner that protects children from exposure to obscene content as called for by Florida law (Florida Statutes, Chapter 847).

WHEREAS the American Library Association has resolved to challenge CIPA in federal courts;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Florida Library Association endorses and supports this legal action by the American Library Association.
