**Friends of YALSA** is a restricted fund that the YALSA Board of Directors uses to support the following areas: advocacy, continuous learning, planning for the future, research, and teen literacy and young adult literature. Each year, Friends of YALSA funds sponsor a Spectrum Scholar, Emerging Leaders, and then support one of the five action areas. In 2010, the action area is advocacy.

**YALSA Leadership Endowment** is an endowment established in 2008 by YALSA Past Presidents and only the interest from it may be used to support leadership initiatives, such as mentoring programs, scholarships and leadership institutes.

**Bill Morris Endowment for Young Adult Literature** is an endowment established in 2003 by the late William C. Morris, an influential innovator in the publishing world and an advocate for marketing books for children and young adults. Endowment funds helped YALSA launch the Odyssey Award, the Morris Award, and the biennial Young Adult Literature Symposium. The endowment will be used by YALSA to help future generations of librarians explore the vibrant world of young adult literature so that they may be able to connect their teen patrons to young adult literature in meaningful and innovative ways.
