Policy Statement:

The AASL Induction Program Committee will administer the AASL Induction Program.

Focus:

Primary: AASL Executive Committee, AASL Induction Program Committee

Purpose:

To describe the duties of the Induction Program Committee.

Procedure:

Committee objective(s):

To administer the AASL Induction Program.

1. Selection of inductees to Induction Program annually.
2. Instructing online coursework with inductees.
3. Review and updating of coursework annually.

Committee composition:

1. The chair is appointed by the AASL President-Elect for a two-year term. Prior Induction Program Committee experience is preferred. Position is limited to four consecutive years. May resume committee chair position after one year off the Induction Program Committee.
2. Committee members should consist of a minimum of eight members, appointed by the AASL President-Elect for two-year terms. Prior Induction Program experience preferred, either as a committee member or inductee. Position is limited to two consecutive terms.

Committee responsibilities:

1. Selection of inductee classes using committee developed rubric.
2. Serve as instructors for the online coursework on the Induction Program.
3. Review and update coursework annually.
