Policy Statement:

To stipulate that links to any sites not hosted on the American Library Association Server or to any sites that sell or require a subscription, must provide relevant information for school librarians; ease of accessibility, use and ability to search; and authority information for the site.

Focus:

AASL Members

Purpose:

To ensure that the AASL website is used to serve the association.

Procedure:

1. The ALA copyright/disclaimer statement that appears on all ALA web pages shall also appear at the bottom of all American Association of School Librarians (AASL) web pages, including those web pages that contain links to commercial or non-ALA sites.
2. AASL does not exert editorial control over materials that are posted by third parties.
3. AASL is not responsible for any materials that are posted by third parties.
4. AASL specifically disclaims any and all liability for any claims or damages which result from any postings by third parties
5. All electronic resources resulting from the work of committees, task forces, sections, or other group of the American Association of School Librarians (AASL) shall reside on the American Library Association (ALA) server unless the AASL Executive Director determines that it is not technically feasible to do so. In those cases, AASL may enter into a contract with a vendor to host that resource.
