Whereas Baugh worked in IT and operations at UMD for over 20 years and most recently served as the Director of IT & Facilities at the UMD College of Information Studies (INFO); David Baugh also served as the college's interim Assistant Dean of Finance and Administration;

Whereas Baugh received a Bachelor of Science (BS) from the University of Maryland and Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the University of Maryland Global Campus; Baugh had worked in the iSchool since 2006;

Whereas Baugh was known to be a genuine caring colleague; Baugh was the recipient of the INFO college's inaugural William "Bill" G.
