Whereas Susana Liu served as a Librarian in numerous institutions such as San Jose State University, City College of San Francisco, Stanford University, Foothill College, Texas A&M University, Rice University, University of Missouri, Columbia, and Cleveland State University;

Whereas Liu received her Master of Science in Library Sciences from Case Western Reserve University; Master of Arts in Instructional Technology from San Jose State University; Bachelor of Arts from National Chung Hsing University; and

Whereas at the Chinese American Librarians Association (CALA), she served as President of Chinese American Librarians Association; she made a tremendous effort in merging local associations from the Chinese Librarians Association in California to join the Chinese American Librarians Association in 1983; she served in numerous leadership roles, mentored many CALA members and always encouraged impactful action; now, therefore, be it
