ALA Connect Update: in the Fall of 2016 ALA plans to replace the current Connect with a much-improved version. Information below will be updated where applicable.

ALA Connect

ALA Connect is the main workspace for the Board and all committees. It can be used to share documents, post committee minutes, and as a discussion list (listserv), which is why we don't maintain separate division/section committee discussion lists. Every division level and section level committee has its own space in Connect.

Connect Basics

If you haven't used Connect, go to the site and login with your ALA ID/password. You'll find the committees and groups that you're part of in the left-hand navigation tabs. When you choose a committee from this list, you'll see all the information for that committee – members, recent documents and discussion, etc. Use the toolbar to filter the content, add new content (with the “Add New” button), etc.

It is best to set your Connect account to automatically receive email notifications when new posts have been added to your committee(s). To do so, click on the account menu in the upper right hand corner of the page and go to "Edit my Notifications". On that page check the boxes next to “Active” for your committees and you'll receive email notifications of new committee activity. Also under the account menu is where you can edit your profile by adding a picture and other information about yourself, so other ALA members can learn more about you.
