The Award is given annually to a new writer and a new illustrator for a picture book that:

- Highlights the universal qualities of childhood and the strength of the family
- Reflects the multicultural nature of our world
- Has an original text and original story (no folktales)
- Unifies illustrations and text
- Avoids stereotypes
- Is **respectful** of the reader's intelligence, sensitivity, curiosity, and love of learning
- Demonstrates excellent command of the chosen medium
- Displays freshness and originality of language and literary/artistic expression
