The other location suggested was the Green Lantern Bar, where we held the 2019 social hour. Several participants voiced concern about the location not being ADA compliant (stairs) with loud music. Approved.

Eran Berman is taking over as councilor for a year, then the position will be put on the ballot for next year. Council is talking about getting rid of council forum. This is up for debate. The meeting for the consolidation of the Round Table Coordinating bylaws will be up for approval.
