

## RESOLUTION

Whereas the American Library Association is committed to human rights and social justice, regardless of origin, color, creed, race, country, or religion; and

Whereas the American Library Association honors these commitments through the activities of its members organizationally and individually; and

Whereas the American Library Association is a member of the International Federation of Library Associations (IFLA), which has lost its consultative status with UNESCO on grounds of racial discrimination; be it therefore

Resolved, that the American Library Association immediately terminate its membership in, and all relationships with, IFLA, until its consultative status is restored by UNESCO; and be it further

Resolved, that the American Library Association shall have no affiliations with or memberships in other organizations which violate its principles and commitments to human rights and social justice.
