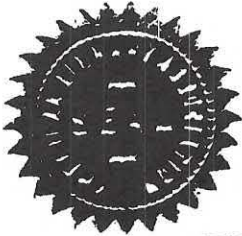

RESOLUTION ON THE ENVIRONMENT

- Whereas, On April 22, 1990 people in the United States will be celebrating the twentieth anniversary of Earth Day, and
- Whereas, Libraries and librarians have been concerned and active in disseminating information on the environmental problems of our Earth, and
- Whereas, Many libraries have active recycling, educational and other programs supportive of civic environmental groups and research efforts, and
- Whereas, These efforts have not yet become a general policy of the American Library Association urged upon all libraries and librarians, therefore be it
- Resolved, That the American Library Association encourage libraries to celebrate Earth Day as a way to focus public attention on environmental issues, and be it further
- Resolved, That the American Library Association urge librarians and library governing boards to collect and provide information on the condition of our Earth, its air, ground, water and living organisms from all available sources.
