
At its meeting November 19–20, 2012, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA Committee on Recognition reviewed the information the American Library Association Committee on Accreditation (ALA-COA) provided to the Board of Directors for consideration at the September 24–25, 2012 Board of Directors meeting.

Consistent with our July 9, 2012 letter, the committee will make its recognition decision after ALA-COA completes the process for its programs to “report how and where the program publicly provides evidence of assessment and evaluation of student achievement” as part of the Biennial Narrative Report due by December 1, 2012 and provides additional information to the Committee. CHEA will work with ALA-COA to determine a date to submit the additional evidence that the organization fully meets Paragraph 12(B)(1) of the *2006 CHEA Recognition Policy and Procedures* for the committee’s consideration at the March 2013 Committee on Recognition.
