



MEMORIAL RESOLUTION HONORING DEVONA PENDERGRASS

Whereas the American Library Association (ALA) and the broader library community lost a valued member and leader on May 2nd, 2021, with the death of Devona Pendergrass;

Whereas Devona Pendergrass served more than as an employee of Mountain Home Public Schools for 35 years, including roles as Kindergarten Librarian, High School Librarian, and District Library Team Leader;

Whereas Devona Pendergrass served with excellence on the American Association of School Librarians Board of Directors and had a life-long commitment to serving young people in her community and supporting youth everywhere;

Whereas Devona Pendergrass served the Arkansas Association of Instructional Media (serving in various executive roles), and the Arkansas Association of School Libraries (serving as President and Constitution Chair) and was a charter member of the Arkansas Rural Educators Association;

Whereas Devona Pendergrass' warmth, kindness, and commitment enriched those fortunate enough to know and work with her;

Whereas her true legacy lies in the lasting effect she has on the thousands of young people she taught in school libraries, now, therefore, be it
