

REPORT OF THE ALA COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES

In accordance with the Constitution Article VII, Section 1 and 2, Bylaws Article III, Section 6(c), and Policy A.5.3, the Council Committee on Committees submits the following slate of candidates for the election by Council of **FOUR (4)** ALA Executive Board members. **The first THREE (3)** candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to 3-year terms (2018-2021), and seated on the Executive Board at its fall meeting on October 27-29, 2018, in Chicago, IL. The **FOURTH (4th)** candidate receiving the greatest number of votes will be seated immediately on the ALA Executive Board at the 2018 Midwinter Meeting to complete the remaining 5 months (February 2018 through June 2018) of Loida Garcia-Febo's ALA Executive Board Member-at-Large term. Additional nominations may be made from the Council floor.

Because any one of the nominated candidates could be elected to complete the 5-month term, which will begin with the third Executive Board meeting at the 2018 Midwinter Meeting, all potential candidates must have at least served on Council at both the 2017 ALA Midwinter Meeting and the 2017 ALA Annual Conference.
