will allow Wood Library to:

- Expand Saturday hours and open on Sunday
- Restore and expand collections, including eBooks
- Restore and add children, teen, and adult programming
- Restore professional reference services
- Invest in the most recent technologies such as Chromebooks, Macs, and more eReaders
- Add technology assistance through tutoring sessions and classes
- Increase collaborations with our schools and other community partners

For less than one dollar a week\*, you will get a thriving library that is open to everyone and has a stable source and adequate level of funding for the first time in its history.

## Voting NO

means the Library will be forced to:

- Close an additional day per week
- Cut back on children's programming, including Monday's Time for Twos and Monday is Funday and other programs in the summer
- Cut all Teen/Tween programming, including Teen Nites, Teen Theater and the Comic Creation and Publishing Workshop and other summer programs
- Eliminate adult learning programs such as computer classes and technology tutoring sessions
- Reduce technology and professional reference assistance
- Reduce new materials purchases for all collections by at least one-third, slash periodical subscriptions and reduce e-book availability
- Prolong wait times for holds and other library services because of staff cuts
- Limit computer updates and upgrades resulting in slower, older computers
- Eliminate investments in new technology purchases

\*Community-based funding amounts to an estimated 29 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value on properties across the Canandaigua City School District. On a property assessed at \$160,000, the tax bill to support Wood Library will be about \$46 a year, less than a dollar a week.
