The 2021 YA Services Symposium will be held in Reno, NV, with hotel rooms at The Row (Silver Legacy, Circus, Circus, and El Dorado). Circus, Circus offers a non-smoking and non-gaming tower. The Symposium event space is across the street from the hotels also in a non-smoking, non-gaming venue November 7-9, 2021, with rates as low as \$60 a night on Thursday and Sunday and \$130 a night on Friday and Saturday.
