

**YALSA Board of Directors Meeting
2007 Annual Conference
Washington, DC, June 21-27, 2007**

Topic: RBA: New Taskforce for Wiki Booklists

Background: YALSA member Stephanie Squicciarini is requesting that YALSA establish a task force to post booklists on the public wiki. Details, including a rationale, are provided below.

Action Required: Action

REQUEST: To create and appoint a virtual committee whose charge would be to compile list request compilations (subject/genre list requests) from YALSA-BK and post onto YALSA wiki that could then be added to regularly.

RATIONALE: These YALSA-BK lists are tremendously helpful for librarians and several times repeated queries are posted or queries for updates to the compilations. To have a place that members could refer to and add to as new titles are suggested without having to search the list archives would be a fabulous resource. And since this would be an email based system the entire committee could be virtual and thus would get even more YALSA members, especially those that cannot attend conferences, involved. These lists could ultimately be published in print editions with potential for generating revenue for YALSA.

TASKFORCE: 5-7 again, all virtual members.

OTHER ACTION: If this idea works, the potential also exists for similar committees/wiki compilations from other lists, program ideas, TAG ideas, etc.
