

The MAE Award for a Young Adult Reading or Literature Program

This award is designed to honor a member(s) of the Young Adult Library Services Association who has developed an outstanding reading or literature program for young adults. The award provides a grant of \$1,000 to support the winning member's attendance at the upcoming ALA Annual Conference.

AWARD CRITERIA

The purpose of the reading or literature program must be to bring young adults and books together and to encourage the development of life-long reading habits.

The program must be specifically designed for and targeted at reaching young adults.

All or part of the program must have taken place in the twelve months preceding the award deadline date of December 1.

The applicant must work directly with young adults and be a **personal** member of the Young Adult Library Services Association.

Non-winning entries may be resubmitted in subsequent years if the program is current and ongoing and if a new application that updates the documentation is submitted.
